The City of Austin’s Hornsby Bend Biosolids Management Plant, most known for “Dillo Dirt”, also processes all of Austin’s yard trimmings, generates electricity from methane, is the site of a farm fertilized by biosolids, and hosts the Center for Environmental Research. Presenters Jody Slagle and Orren West will discuss history, current operations and future plans for the facility. Jody is the process engineer assigned to Hornsby, and has worked at Hornsby Bend for the last 14 years. Jody is actively involved numerous organizations throughout the area related to composting. Orren is the Superintendent at Hornsby Bend and has worked at Hornsby for the last 17 years. Orren started as an operator and promoted over the years. The Hornsby Bend facility currently has approximately 40 full time employees.
