SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE FOR ASSISTANCE?

To be eligible for scholarship assistance from the V. M. Ehlers Foundation, Inc. you must:

- Have been an **active individual dues paid member** of the Texas Water Utilities Association, or an active dues paid member of a Sponsoring Organization that has a fully vested Endowment within the Foundation for a period of not less than twelve months preceding the date the application is received by the V. M. Ehlers Foundation, Inc.
- Or be the **dependent child of an active individual dues paid member (A dependent child is still being supported by their parent(s) and are claimed on their parent(s) income tax return.)**
- Pursuing a course of study that supports the water utilities industry. Students pursuing a post-baccalaureate degree (Masters or Doctorate) are not eligible.

IMPORTANT – READ THIS CAREFULLY

The V. M. Ehlers Foundation, Inc. was organized in 1959 to honor and memorialize Mr. Victor M. Ehlers, who passed away on March 29, 1959 after a distinguished career in the water utilities profession. Mr. Ehlers, or "Vic" as he was known to his friends, was instrumental in the formation of what is now the largest organization of its type in the world - the Texas Water Utilities Association.

The Foundation operates as a Texas non-profit organization and promotes its founding purposes by offering scholarship assistance which will further the water related education of members - and the dependent sons and daughters of members - of the Texas Water Utilities Association. Members - and the dependent sons and daughters of members - of the Water Environment Association of Texas and other organizations having fully funded endowments are also eligible for assistance through Endowments organized within the V. M. Ehlers Foundation, Inc.

Scholarship assistance is paid to recipients in two installments, 50% for the Fall Semester and 50% for the Spring Semester. **All recipients are required to provide the Foundation with a copy of their transcript or grade report for the Fall Semester in order to receive payment for the Spring Semester. Students failing the Fall Semester will not receive scholarship money for the Spring Semester.** Grade reports must have the students name on them.

The Foundation and its Endowments fund scholarship recipients as either Full Time or Part Time Students. For purposes of this definition a Full Time student is one taking not less than 12 semester hours, and a Part Time student is one taking not less than 6 semester hours. Scholarship amounts may be reduced on a pro-rata basis for those students completing less than the defined course loads.
