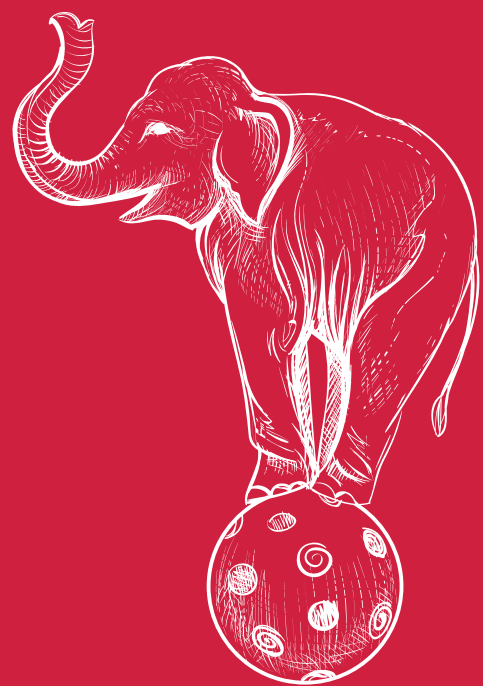

INFORMATION
