- Newspaper and magazine entries consisting of a large number of pages will be displayed digitally as part of Texas Water 2023[™].
- 4. Radio and television entries should include the complete script (if a script was used) and a brief summary or outline of the program's content. Radio entries must be accompanied by an audio version. Television entries must be accompanied by a video with audio.
- **5.** Only published or broadcast material will be judged.
- **6.** Paid advertising is not eligible.
- **7.** TAWWA or WEAT members may not enter for media, but should encourage their local media to enter.
- 8. Entrants may submit no more than two entries. Each entrant can receive only one award.
- **9.** Winners will be notified by March 7, 2023 Entries will not be returned.
- 10. Winners will be recognized during the Texas Water 2023[™] conference, April 11-14 at the George R. Brown Convention Center, Houston.
- Judging: Entries are judged based on water interest, accuracy, clarity, style and impact. Judges may be members of TAWWA or WEAT, instructors or professors of communication in accredited Texas schools or members of the publishing and broadcasting fields who are not currently employed by Texas media.
